TOAST: To the Tampa Bay Lightning. Now we don't have to put up with those moronic Flames fans and their ridiculous car flags.

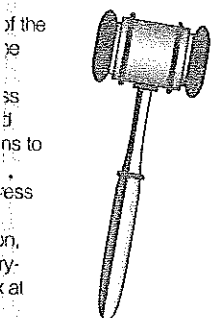
TOAST: To Gary Klassen, real estate agent, and his work. We were so happy with it that my wife wrote a poem for him.
